# SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Scholarship value is \$1000, \$500 credited in the first semester and \$500 in the second semester.
- Applicants will not receive any monetary payment to the value of the scholarship unless fees have already been paid or fees are less than the \$1000 amount, in which case the student may receive a cheque.
- Any monetary payments the student receives is to be spent towards educational related materials such as textbooks, tools, uniform or tuition fees and/or to assist with financial hardship as outlined in the student's application.
- Scholarship award is non-transferable and the scholarship amount will only be awarded once the student has enrolled in each semester. If the student withdraws from the course, they are no longer eligible to receive the scholarship amount. The student must present their Semester 1 transcript of results to Student Wellbeing before they will have access to the Semester 2, 2020 scholarship amount.
- An applicant may only be awarded one scholarship during their study at Holmesglen.
- All correspondence will be via email, including acknowledgement of receipt of applications.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Prospective or current Holmesglen students are eligible to apply.
- Only Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people are eligible to apply. Proof of Aboriginality is required.

- Applicants who are a family member of a Holmesglen employee or agent are not eligible to apply.
- Applicants cannot be a recipient of any other scholarship/award.
- Documentary evidence is required to support your application.

## SELECTION PROCESS

1. Applicants are required to complete the Koorie Access Scholarship Application Form and attach their additional supporting documents.
2. **Please write and tell us, in no more than 500 words, why you have chosen the course and what completing the course will do for your future.**
3. Applicants are recommended to request the assistance of a Student Counsellor to complete their application.
4. Submit application and documentation to Student Wellbeing at Chadstone, Glen Waverley or Moorabbin Campus or by email to: [indigenous@holmesglen.edu.au](mailto:indigenous@holmesglen.edu.au).
5. The Holmesglen Scholarship review panel will assess all applications and make a final decision on whether the application is successful or unsuccessful.
6. Successful applicants will be notified in writing via email.
7. The decision of the Holmesglen Scholarship review panel is final and no further communication will be entered into.
